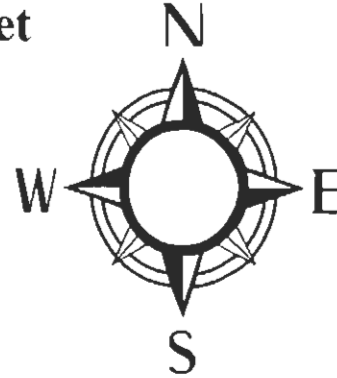

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS:

\$50 non-refundable application fee – page 2

Application fees can be paid by check made payable to *The University of Arizona* or via a charge to your bursar's account. Please indicate which option you prefer.

Application – page 3

All parts of the application must be submitted by the deadline. An application specific to the foreign university may be necessary, which can be obtained from your SASE advisor. Please turn the foreign university application in with your SASE application.

Essay Page – page 4

Please read essay guidelines closely before typing your 550-word, one-page personal statement. You are welcome to type your essay directly onto the attached page or you may submit it on a separate sheet; the essay page is also available as a PDF file online. Some UA program applications require an additional essay/statement of purpose; please consult with your SASE advisor.

Signed course sheet as approved by academic advisor – page 5

Review all coursework you wish to take with your college advisor for general education requirements and your major advisor for major/minor classes. It is advisable to have one or two alternate classes approved in case of course cancellations.

Two Academic References – page 6/7

Two letters are required. The references should be from persons familiar with your college background (professors, TAs, and university lecturers). Be sure references are aware of your application deadline.

Letters in sealed envelopes should be given directly to the student.

Estimated Cost Worksheet – page 8

Student loans and Pell Grants can typically be used for study abroad. Tuition waivers and some scholarships *do not* apply to study abroad or exchange programs. If you currently receive a scholarship, check with the scholarship office to check its validity abroad; then, meet with your SASE advisor to complete an Estimated Cost Worksheet. The Financial Aid Office will then re-evaluate the amount of aid awarded based on your study abroad costs.

ADDITIONAL APPLICATION INFORMATION

Academic transcripts

Please submit one official (sealed) and one unofficial transcript with your application. Order transcripts in person in the Administration Building rm. 210 or online at: www.registrar.arizona.edu/transcripts

Application copies

Please make two *complete* copies of your application packet. Submit the original and one copy to SASE. Keep the extra copy for reference during your studies abroad.

A minimum of two recent passport-size photos

UA requires 2 photos to be submitted as part of the application process. Some programs require additional photos. Please check with your SASE advisor.

Method of Payment

YES! Please charge my Study Abroad and Student Exchange application fee (\$50) to my UA student account. I agree to pay the fee within 5 days after the charge has been posted to my UA account.

Note: The UA Bursar's Office charges a Past Due Balance fee to accounts with any past due balance. This fee will be charged at \$2.00, or 1.5% of the past due balance, whichever is greater. Until the account is paid in full, University of Arizona services will be withheld, including but not limited to registration, grades, transcripts, and diplomas. If further action is warranted, the debtor (student account holder) will be responsible for all collection costs and legal fees.
